
Mick's spring recipe:

Spring Chicken Fricassee

#### Ingredients

- 225g Baby Carrots
- 225g Button Onions
- 225g Broccoli florets
- 225g Full-Fat Soft Cheese with Garlic & Herbs
- 8 Chicken Breast fillets
- 15ml Plain Flour
- 30ml Oil
- 100ml Dry Vermouth
- 300ml Chicken Stock
- 30ml Chopped Tarragon
- 1 Garlic Clove, crushed
- 60ml Single Cream
- Carrot tops to garnish

#### Method





3. Heat the Oil in a shallow flameproof casserole. Brown the Chicken pieces a few at a time, adding more oil as necessary. Remove with a slotted spoon. Add the carrots and onions to the casserole and brown lightly

4.Return the Chicken to the pan and pour in the vermouth and stock. Bring to the boil, stirring in the tarragon, garlic and seasoning.



## NHS Screening

The benefits of having a screening test include:

The main aim of the **FAST campaign** is to help people recognise the symptoms of a stroke - and to think **FAST**. What is a stroke? A stroke is a brain attack. It happens when the blood supply to the brain is disrupted. Most strokes occur when a blood clot blocks the flow of the blood to the brain. **FAST** requires an assessment of three specific symptoms of stroke,

Facial weakness - can the person smile, Has their mouth or eye drooped?

Arm weakness - can the person raise both arms?

**Speech problems** - can the person speak clearly and understand what you say?
