As an exciting consequence we have been approached by community members to provide more

intergenerational activities. Our Community Café that we hold every Thursday morning is thriving with a whole host of activities that include ping pong with an age range of participants from 3 years of age up to 90.

We piloted an intergenerational Easter event and our lovely choir had a wonderful time singing with the children from St. Luke's School. We are very fortunate to have St. Matthews Community centre at the heart of the Holbeck Community and look forward to seeing an ever expanding range of activities in this historical space for both the young and older members of the community.

Hot meals in Holbeck Julie the chef and the catering team of volunteers prepare hot lunches every Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday as well as a monthly Sunday lunch and a supper club. For just £5 for a three course meal in good company, the meals are a real bargain. Transport can also be provided to collect you from your home and return you afterwards. For those that are housebound, we have recently introduced an Outreach "Meals On Wheels" service on Tuesdays. The freshly cooked meals are sealed and kept hot whilst delivered to your door throughout the LS11 postcode area at an introductory offer of £2. Julie is hopeful that this service will operate more days per week as the numbers using the service increased throughout the year. Julie's background in catering stems from having trained at Thomas Danby College and managed the catering in care homes, prison and hotels. She then spent 20 years in the financial services sector and thought she had put cheffing behind her. But one year ago she stepped in to cover our meal service for two weeks and she's still here. Of course Julie can't do all of this on her own and is full of praise for her team of volunteers: "They're absolutely



brill!" she enthuses. Gerry, a pensioner who helps regularly. At first just pottered, but then Julie asked him to help prepare the vegetables. From there she taught him how to make a quiche and he's taken these new skills back to his own kitchen at home. There's a great camaraderie amongst the volunteers and they're always looking for new helpers to join the team. The service is in great hands and looks set to grow and grow.




