Staying healthy this autumn

Get the flu vaccine

It is recommended that adults aged 65 and older get a flu vaccine each year, ideally by the end of October. While the flu shot is recommended for every person above six months of age, older people are especially at risk for complications from the flu, such as pneumonia, bronchitis and ear infections. The flu can also make any chronic health problems worse. There are two types of flu shots specially designed for seniors. Ask your GP which one would be best for you.

Protect your skin

Indoor air becomes arid thanks to household heating systems. With age, our skin gets thinner and more prone to dryness and tears that can lead to infections. Stay hydrated by drinking plenty of fluids and eating soup. Using a humidifier indoors can go a long way toward putting some much-needed moisture back into the air. Also, make sure to help keep your skin from drying out with lotion or cream.

So, what is Your Space? Our team provides a community wellbeing service for people aged 16+ across South and East Leeds. Your Space is a service that aims to help protect your wellbeing and prevent mental health difficulties through social connection, learning opportunities and fun activities. Day to day this means you can find us planning and running events in the community like our popular curry club; journaling group; chocolate, chat and chill; and local LGBTQ+ Socials from our office in the Jamyang Buddhist Centre in Holbeck. We also offer wellbeing training sessions to local employers

and community groups about common concerns like stress and sleeplessness. The team also do outreach at existing groups and events. You may have seen me doing taster sessions of some of our activities at the HEA Wellbeing Breakfasts too!
