Lunch Club and Community Café Volunteer, Holbeck Together



What the roles involve and skills required

- Preparing and serving food at our regular lunch club and community café based at St Matthews Community Centre in Holbeck on various weekday mornings, afternoons and monthly on Sundays.
- You will help set tables, serve food and talk to customers so a friendly, sociable manner is essential.
- Time commitment is flexible, involving a weekly commitment of 2-3 hours usually during weekday daytimes and ongoing reliability is essential.
- Previous catering experience is advantageous but not essential and a Food
 Hygiene certificate can be obtained alongside the role.
- A DBS check is required for all volunteer roles, which is paid for by the organisation and a criminal record does not automatically exclude you from volunteering.
- Holbeck Together operates a Covid-safe environment for all its volunteers and staff, you will be given full instructions as part of your volunteer induction.

What can I gain from this role?

- Training and Induction is provided as part of your role as well as out-of-pocket expenses.
- You will be joining a friendly team of volunteers who help deliver different roles for services across the organisation.
- This role may suit people wanting to gain catering experience and a Food Hygiene certificate can be obtained.
- You can access a variety of training and support across Holbeck Together via your Volunteer Coordinator.
