What the role involves and skills required?

- Delivering Holbeck Together's quarterly newsletter and leaflets to residents and organisations in the local area.
- This is an ad-hoc role every few months and can be done flexibly, on foot or by using a vehicle, any travel costs directly incurred would be reimbursed.
- Knowledge of the local area/LS11 is desirable and the role can be done with other volunteers.
- A DBS check is required for all volunteer roles, which is paid for by the organisation and a criminal record does not automatically exclude you from volunteering.
- Holbeck Together operates a Covid-safe environment for all its volunteers and staff, you will be given full instructions as part of your volunteer induction.

What can I gain from this role?

- Training and Induction is provided as part of your role as well as out-of-pocket expenses.
- You will be joining a friendly team of volunteers who help deliver different roles for services across the organisation.
