# Coping with the Rising Cost of Living

Millions of people across the UK are struggling to cover their essential household costs nowadays. The 'cost of living crisis' means we're all paying a lot more for energy and food, and things like rent and fuel.

Some people are cutting back on how much they spend on food, or eating less, so they can pay for heating. Many people are falling into arrears, or using credit to pay for essentials, making the problem worse.

Sadly, the situation isn't going to get easier, even as temporary support measures are announced, further challenges are ahead. Energy bills have increased by an average of £700 a year and council tax payments are on the rise. If you have a job, what you pay in National Insurance contributions has gone up.

A lot of people are finding that wages and benefit payment increases aren't keeping track with these price rises.

# Money back if paying council tax

 $(\downarrow)$ 

You can get £150 back from the council to help with the rising cost of living – this is called a 'rebate'. You'll get the rebate if you pay council tax and your home is in council tax bands A to D. You can find your band on your council tax bill or check your council tax band on GOV.UK

# One off 'energy support' payment from government

The government will give every household in Great Britain £400 off their electricity bill. The £400 will be automatically added to your energy account over 6 months starting from October 2022 and you won't have to pay it back. If you have a prepayment meter, the £400 will be added to your meter or you'll be given vouchers.

# Extra 'cost of living grant' for lowest-income households

Eight million of the UK's lowestincome households will also be eligible for a one off £650 Cost of Living grant. The grant will be received by those households who receive means-tested benefits. You cannot apply for this grant - if you are eligible to receive the grant, you will automatically be paid the £650 across two payments.

All generations of Holbeck came together to celebrate Her Majesty's Platinum Jubliee with tea, cake and live music at St Matthews.

Lots of wonderful community events took place in Holbeck to celebrate this special occasion and it was great for us to part of these.

CELEBRATING



The Ruth Gorse Academy invited some of our Holbeck residents to join them for Afternoon Tea served by young people from the college, followed by an afternoon of bingo and musical acts from students and teachers.

Slung Low and The Holbeck also held a 'Golden Ticket' event for invited local residents. Guests were treated to a day packed full of entertainment, including a brass band and acts playing tribute to the different generations of the Queen's reign.



We are supporting Leeds City Council to develop a multi-millionpound proposal for regeneration of the centre of Holbeck. The proposals will be submitted to the Government's Levelling Up Fund – which is available for investing in local communities. Competition will be tough but we are hopeful that our ideas and proposals are strong.

The bid will include significant investment into improving buildings and outdoor spaces in and around St Matthews Community Centre and Domestic Street.

The 'Heart of Holbeck' proposals could include funding to enable:

- Physical repair and improvement works to St Matthews Community Centre.
- Renovation of the interior of Holbeck Together's current office space – The Old Box Office – to extend the space available for the community to use and repurpose its existing use.

The rest of the bid will be asking for investment from the Levelling Up Fund to support:

• Major environmental improvements to Holbeck Moor such as new play equipment and skate park, better pedestrian links and routes, a community event space, and major new planting.

- Improvements on many of the local streets to add more street greenery and pocket parks and create a better pedestrian environment.
- Revitalisation of the local centre along Domestic Street to create more space for pedestrians.
- Potentially extending previous successful group repair projects to back-to-back housing streets to improve their energy efficiency.

These projects have been specifically identified through ongoing consultation with the community.

The plans are being backed by Hilary Benn MP and local Councillors.

Although there is no guarantee that the area will be successful in securing the funding a proposal will be submitted to the Government at the start of July. We are hoping to hear whether the proposals are successful later in the year.

Elissa Newman, our Chief Officer, Holbeck Together has called the ideas for regeneration being explored in this bid as a potential 'game-changer' for people living and working in the local area. "Holbeck has a rich history shaped by the people who have lived and worked in the area. It's a history brimming with pride, entrepreneurship and success. The Levelling Up agenda set out by the Government is about creating equality of opportunity across communities in the UK. It's about giving everyone the chance to flourish. It means people everywhere living longer and more fulfilling lives, and benefitting from sustained rises in living standards and well-being.

We've been a part of the community for 30 years. We are proud to be a community anchor – responding to and supporting the changing needs and situations that our community experience. We feel fortunate to have been approached to work in partnership with the Council to contribute to and build the ideas for the area and we want to make sure the communities' opinions are captured and included.

This bid could make a significant visible difference to the Holbeck area – restoring spaces and creating wider opportunities and we will keep everyone up to date with developments as we find out more."
