

## Volunteer Minibus Driver



### What the role involves, and skills required

- Driving one of our 16 seat minibuses on regular outings with our clients including collecting and dropping off passengers.
- Alongside the passenger assistant/s you will ensure passengers are able to safely get on and off the bus and maintain their safety during journeys through regular friendly conversations such as about seatbelt instructions.
- You will ensure a vehicle safety check is carried out prior to all trips, ensure the bus is in safe working order and report any defects or accidents immediately.
- You will need a full UK Driving Licence with D1 category status, if you have a MIDAS certificate it is advantageous but if not we can arrange this for you. Previous minibus driving experience is desirable but not essential and you will be supported by our main minibus driver to prepare you to do the role.
- You will need good driving, navigation and communication skills, be physically fit and have a friendly, caring manner with clients.
- Due to minibus driving insurance criteria you must be aged between 25 and 69.
- Time commitment is flexible, involving a minimum weekly commitment of 3-4 hours usually during weekday daytimes or some weekends. Some trips require a full day commitment and reliability is essential.
- A DBS check is required for all volunteer roles, which is paid for by the organisation and a criminal record does not automatically exclude you from volunteering.
- Holbeck Together operates a Covid-safe environment for all its volunteers and staff, you will be given full instructions as part of your volunteer induction.

### What can I gain from this role?

- Training and Induction is provided as part of your role as well as out-of-pocket expenses including personal travel and a meal during outings.
- You will be joining a friendly team of volunteers who help deliver different

roles for services across the organisation.

- This role may suit people wanting to use or gain driving experience.
- You can access a variety of training and support across Holbeck Together via your Volunteer Coordinator.
