Heart of Holbeck development plans

Many readers will already be aware of the Heart of Holbeck project, and we know local people have been keen to hear more about when plans will start to move forward. I am pleased to share an update on this major investment in our local area, which brings together Leeds City Council, Holbeck Together, Leeds Building Society and other partners with a shared commitment to improving everyday life in Holbeck.

This is an exciting moment for our community. The project has secured more than £15 million through the Regeneration Fund (previously known as the Levelling Up Fund): a Government investment which will support improvements to community spaces, housing, highways, green spaces and public areas.

With Leeds City Council leading on the project co-ordination and the management of the funding we are delighted to be a key partner, with support from Leeds Building Society. The allocation of funding will directly support the plans to modernise St Matthews Community Centre and the future community use of the Old Box Office. Our ambition is to create welcoming, flexible and accessible spaces for people of all ages, as well as local groups, services and organisations.

A huge amount of work has gone into reaching this stage. Projects like this do not happen overnight. Over several years, partners have worked together to understand local need, shape proposals, strengthen plans and make sure the investment reflects what matters to people in Holbeck. As a charity working in the community every day, Holbeck Together has been proud to help bring local voices, experiences and ambitions into those conversations.

This investment is about more than buildings. We know that where people live has a real impact on health and wellbeing.

Safe streets, warmer homes, green spaces, welcoming community buildings and places to connect all make a difference. Heart of Holbeck gives us an opportunity to bring services, support and community activity closer to where people live.

There is still more work ahead, and we will continue to keep local people up to date as the project develops. Recent information events were an important part of that process, and there will be further opportunities to hear updates, ask questions and share views in the months ahead.

We are incredibly excited to be moving closer to getting started. This is a positive investment in Holbeck's future, and we want to ensure that local people feel part of the journey.

Volunteers were also on hand to discuss the organisation's involvement with the local community.

We are extremely grateful to Leeds United staff and players, everyone who donated, and each volunteer who helped to make the event successful. And we also celebrated Leeds United's 3-0 win over Wolverhampton Wanderers!



Over 2,000 football kits received for local children

Leeds United donated over 2000 home and away football kits for children up to 12 years old in the Holbeck area. We distributed these across 5 local schools, and our recently sponsored football club, Holbeck Moor Juniors FC U10 Oranges.

HEALTHY HOLIDAYS SUPPORT SECURED UNTIL EASTER 2027

Holbeck Together are delighted to share that we have recently been successful in our application to Leeds Community Foundation to continue the Healthy Holidays programme in Holbeck to cover the upcoming summer holidays, Christmas 2026 and Easter 2027.

The holidays activities and food (HAF) programme provides healthy meals, fun activities, and free childcare places to children from low-income families, greatly benefitting their health, well-being and learning, whilst also enabling families to

navigate the challenging school holidays.

Holbeck Together has provided this service to local young people and families since the scheme's inception in 2018.

Our most recent provision in the April Easter Holidays engaged 62 participants across 4 activity days. Young people took part in a range of multi-sport physical activities, educational activities and creative sessions. Alongside this our catering service provided 384 meals across the activity days.

Horse-racing partnership helps tackle loneliness and isolation in Holbeck and South Leeds

Through this project, many of our clients have been given opportunities to visit a live racing meet. We have attended race meetings at Pontefract Racecourse, visited the winners' enclosures, met jockeys, and listened to speeches from respected figures within racing, including the legendary Mr Norman Gundill MBE – whose family has been involved in the management of Pontefract racecourse for many generations.

NHS top tips for staying safe in Summer

We all look forward to sunny days, but when temperatures rise too high, it's important to take care. A few simple measures can help you, your family and your community stay safe and well during hot weather this summer.

Tips for coping in hot weather:

- Keep out of the heat if possible. If you are going outside, stay in shaded areas between 11am-3pm.

- Wear sunscreen (SPF 50 where possible), a protective hat and light-coloured clothing (white, grey).

- Avoid exercise or any physical activity.

- Ensure you stay hydrated. Drink lots of cold water (avoid alcohol).

- Have a cool shower to regulate your body temperature.

- Keep your living space cool: Most people think opening windows throughout the day lets heat out, when in fact, it lets heat in. Keep your windows closed until sunset.

HEART OF HOLBECK

Heart of Holbeck: investment in homes, streets and community spaces

Holbeck is a place with a strong identity. It has a fascinating history, green spaces, local organisations, neighbours who look out for one another, and community buildings that already play a big part in everyday life. But local people also know where things need to improve: homes that are hard to keep warm, streets that can feel dominated by traffic, green spaces that could work harder for families, older people and young people, and community buildings that need investment so they can keep supporting local people.

Heart of Holbeck is about bringing these things together. Backed by £15.9 million of UK Government Local Regeneration Funding, the programme is not one single project, but a collection of connected improvements across the area. Each part has a different purpose, but they all share the same aim: to make Holbeck a healthier, greener, safer and more welcoming place to live, visit, work and spend time.



Connecting Holbeck

This project is about making it easier, safer and more enjoyable to move between Holbeck, the city centre and surrounding areas.

What's planned:

- Clearer walking, wheeling and cycling routes
- Better signs and wayfinding
- Safer, more welcoming streets
- Stronger links to the city and South Bank
- More attractive routes that feel cared for

How this helps residents:

- Easier everyday journeys
- More confidence walking locally
- Better access to shops, services, work and green spaces
- A stronger connection between Holbeck and the wider city



Streets and public spaces

The public environment project focuses on the local centre, pavements, crossings, planting and the overall feel of Holbeck's streets.

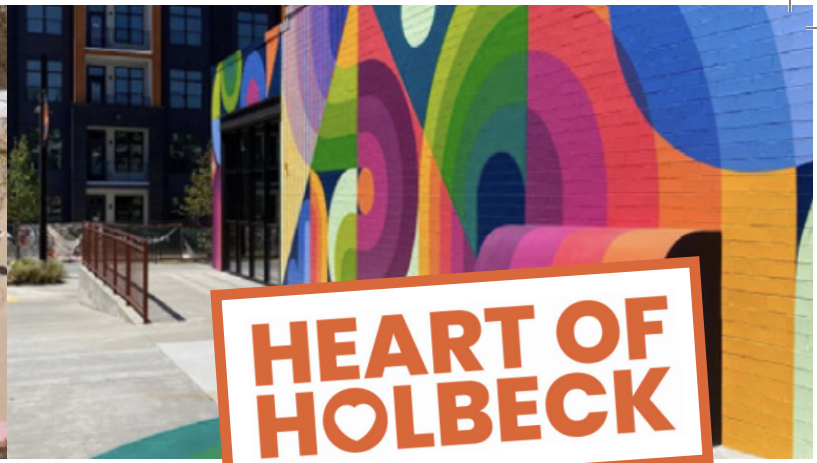
Warmer, greener homes

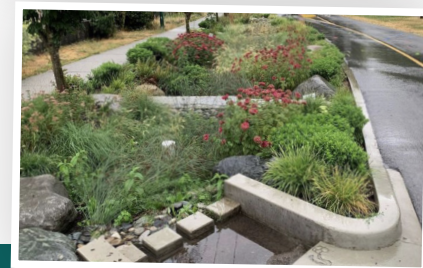

One programme, many local benefits

What makes Heart of Holbeck important is the way the different projects connect. Each project has its own role, but together they add up to something bigger: investment in the everyday life of Holbeck.

For residents, the programme is not just about new paving, planting or building works. It is about warmer living rooms, safer crossings, more welcoming parks, stronger community services, easier journeys and better places to spend time close to home. This programme is about strengthening the places people already value and creating new opportunities for the whole community.

What is 2FA (Two-Factor Authentication)?

Two-Factor Authentication (2FA) adds an extra layer of security to your online accounts. Instead of just using a password, you also need a second form of verification, such as a code sent to your phone or generated by an authenticator app.

Why use it?

Even if someone steals your password, they cannot access your account without the second verification step. Enabling 2FA is one of the best ways to protect your personal and financial information online.

How do I use it?

Websites or apps will often ask you to set up a linked email or phone number when you create an account, change your password, log in from a new device, or access personal or payment information. When you log in to a website or app if the site uses 2FA and you have connected your email or phone number to the site after entering your password, you may be asked to type in a short code sent by text message or email, approve a notification on your phone, or use an authenticator app.

All of this helps keep your account safer, because even if someone guesses your password, they will still need the second code or approval to get in.

Transport



Inspiring Primary Futures

Since October 2025, Holbeck Together's community transport service has played a pivotal role in enabling young people to access after-school activities that develop confidence, help them learn new skills and support them to begin thinking about their future aspirations.

Over this period, the Inspiring Positive Futures programme delivered 85 sessions across LS9, with 72 individual young people accessing the service. A key factor in achieving this reach was the support provided by Holbeck Together Community Transport. For many children and young people, access to transport would otherwise have been a significant barrier to participation. By providing safe and reliable transport to and from activities, Holbeck Together enabled young people to attend sessions they may not otherwise have been able to access, helping to ensure they could benefit from the programme's opportunities and support.



External Minibus Hire

Holbeck Together has been shortlisted for the 'Children's Choice Award' in the category Best Place in Leeds for Children and Young People at the Child Friendly Leeds Awards 2026.

The awards celebrate the people, organisations, schools, charities and community groups making a positive difference to children and young people across the city.

This nomination recognises our ongoing work to create welcoming and inclusive opportunities for local children, young people and families, including holiday activities and trips, family support, community events, Parents and Tots sessions

and intergenerational activities that bring people of all ages together.

Elissa Newman our Chief Officer highlighted: "We are incredibly proud to be shortlisted for this award, especially as it is the Children's Choice award, which is based on children voting for places and organisations that they value and enjoy. Supporting children, young people and families is such an important part of what we do at Holbeck Together, and this nomination is a real tribute to our staff, volunteers, partners and local community who help create spaces where families feel welcomed, listened to and supported."

The winners will be announced at the Child Friendly Leeds Awards ceremony in July 2026.
